
DESERT LOCUST BULLETIN: NO:01-19 (January, 2019)

SITUATION DURING JANUARY, 2019 AND FORECAST FOR FEBRUARY, 2019.

Desert locust Survey and control operations conducted in winter breeding areas of Eritrea along Red sea coast from Massawa to northern part to of the country border to Sudan. Control operation was carried out against gregarious all stages of hopper groups and bands, adult groups and swarms . A total area of 7,665 was treated. Part of the vegetation status was medium green and the rest start to dry. In the forecast period the late instars will likely to develop to immature adult groups. Maintaining regular monitoring is essential during the season.

WEATHER AND ECOLOGICAL CONDITIONS

some of the vegetation status was medium green and the rest start to dry. Most of the soil moisture was wet during the month.

DESERT LOCUST SITUATION

Control operation was carried out against all stages of gregarious hopper groups and bands , fledgling, gregarious immature and mature adults . A total area of 7,665 was treated. From the mentioned treated area, 1,550 ha was surrounded by the Swarms around Massawa which were arrived from Sudan



In the forecast period the late instars will likely to develop to immature adult groups. Maintaining regular monitoring is essential during the season.
